### Q Why did you choose tourism?



### HOTSPOTS EXPLAINED



Simonga Forest - A lush miombo woodland offering excellent sightings of regional specials like the Miombo Rock-Thrush, Racket-tailed Roller, and various woodpeckers.



Zambezi River Islands - A prime spot for waterassociated and riparian forest species, including Pel's Fishing Owl, White-backed Night Heron, African Skimmer and Half-collard Kingfisher



Mosi-Oa-Tunya National Park - A mix of riverine forest, grasslands, and mopane woodland, home to Schalow's Turaco, African Finfoot, and a variety of raptors.



**Livingstone Sewer Ponds / Maramba River** – A magnet for waterbirds and waders, attracting species like Black Crake, Lesser Moorhen, & migrant shorebirds. Maramba River recently home to the rare & elusive Ross's Turaco,



Batoka Gorge (Vic Falls) - A dramatic landscape where cliff-dwelling species thrive, including Rock Pratincole, Verreaux's Eagle & Taita Falcon (status unknown),


